## 2021 SINGLE VINEYARD ANDERSON VALLEY PINOT NOIR

### INTRODUCTION

Our Anderson Valley Pinot Noir comes from our Angel Camp Vineyard in the “Deep End” of the Anderson Valley, north of Philo. Planted on a knoll overlooking the valley below to a mix of Pinot Noir clones, we have plenty of components to work with when crafting the final blend. The red, iron-rich soil lends a mineral note to the wine, and its proximity to the cooling influence of the Pacific Ocean makes this one of our latest picks every year.

### WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2021 Anderson Valley Pinot Noir is deep ruby in color, with red currant, lavender, blackberry and oak spice on the nose. The palate is lush and intense, with pomegranate, blueberry and graphite giving way to an underlying earthiness with hints of baking spice on the finish. Drink from 2023-2029.
