2019 SINGLE-VINEYARD ANDERSON VALLEY PINOT NOIR

INTRODUCTION

One of two Donum wines from the Angel Camp Estate Vineyard in the “deep end” of the Anderson Valley, north of Philo, where ocean fog keeps temperatures cool much of the summer, the Anderson Valley bottling is blended from across the ranch. The vineyard is planted to seven different clones of Pinot Noir in iron-rich, sandy soil at about 500 feet above sea level on a knoll with several different aspects. The Anderson Valley bottling represents a barrel-selected blend from all of these blocks and offers Donum’s interpretation of this remote, fascinating region.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2019 Anderson Valley Pinot Noir is light ruby to garnet in color, with red plum, iron, and dried herb aromas. The palate is red-fruit driven, with cranberry, cherry and pomegranate, along with a subtle sous-bois finish. Nicely structured tannin leaves a lingering spice on the finish. Recommended drinking window is 2022-2026.
