2020 SINGLE VINEYARD ANDERSON VALLEY PINOT NOIR

INTRODUCTION

Our Anderson Valley Pinot Noir comes from our Angel Camp vineyard in the “Deep End” of the Anderson Valley, north of Philo. Planted on a knoll overlooking the valley below to a mix of Pinot Noir clones, we have plenty of components to work with when crafting the final blend. The red, iron-rich soil lends a mineral note to the wine, and its proximity to the cooling influence of the Pacific Ocean makes this one of our latest picks every year.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2020 Anderson Valley Pinot Noir is medium ruby-garnet in color, with classic Anderson Valley aromas of Bing cherry, dusty rose petal, pine and iron. The palate offers flavors of raspberry, red currant, plum and a touch of clove. Tightly wound with spicy, lifted notes of berry and dark chocolate, this wine will continue to evolve in the cellar for years to come. Recommended drinking window is 2023 - 2028.
